- **Re-entry (Mejia, Probation; Brooks, Lived Experience)**
 - Composition of MDT/Treatment Team that develops treatment plans and reviews progress
 - Type of assessment to be used (include Erinn Herberman from Research)
 - Format of the individualized treatment plan (ITP)
 - ITP should be individually tailored:
 - **Include youth, families and other necessary stakeholders** in the process of planning
 - **Address family strengths, risks, and needs** and identify positive community supports for youth and family
 - **Integrate evidence-based, community-based services**, including mental health services, substance-abuse services, trauma treatment, cognitive behavioral therapy/skills, academic support, enrichment programs, and physical activity
 - **Immediately involve re-entry planning** that identifies goals and a pathway towards successful release and transition
 - **Assist with removing or overcoming barriers to success:** tickets and fines, school access, immigration status, securing vital documents and other legal and administrative challenges.
 - Method of tracking progress (frequency of regular meetings, forms, feedback to youth)
 - Finalize court report format (work from Matt's draft based on MSO report)

- **Facility Operations (Green, Probation; Strickland, Probation)**
 - Select units @ EMJDF
 - Space for programming/treatment/MDT meetings
 - Interim services/daily program for July through implementation of procured programming
 - Recommend expanded incentives
 - Identify things that have worked well in YOU that should be replicated

- **Data (Stapley, Probation; Keaton, SANDAG)**
 - Assess data collection needs
 - Measurable outcomes for success

- **Court Operations (Zermeno, Probation; Strickland, Probation)**
 - Provide updates on interim commitment options
 - Respond rapidly to requests from the Court and justice partners
 - Equitable sentencing and commitment options for youth
 - Length of commitment, achieving program milestones

- **Treatment Programs & Services (Regier, Probation; Dr. Nelson, BHS)**
 - Identify programs and timelines for procurement
 - Employment, internship, externship, entrepreneurial support
 - Identify interim services which can be utilized from July 1 until new services are implemented
